There are some special considerations for ESOL assessments.

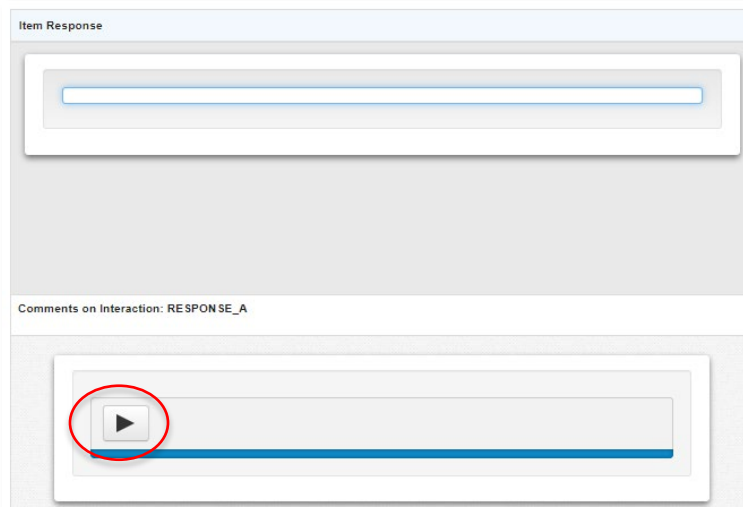

## Scheduling Sessions

ESOL assessments have two parts, reading and writing. Make sure students are set up in sessions for both parts.

## Scoring Audio Items

Some assessments have audio recordings that the scorer will need to listen to in order to assign a score. Depending on your screen resolution, you may need to scroll down to view. See also: *Hand Scoring Constructed Response Items*

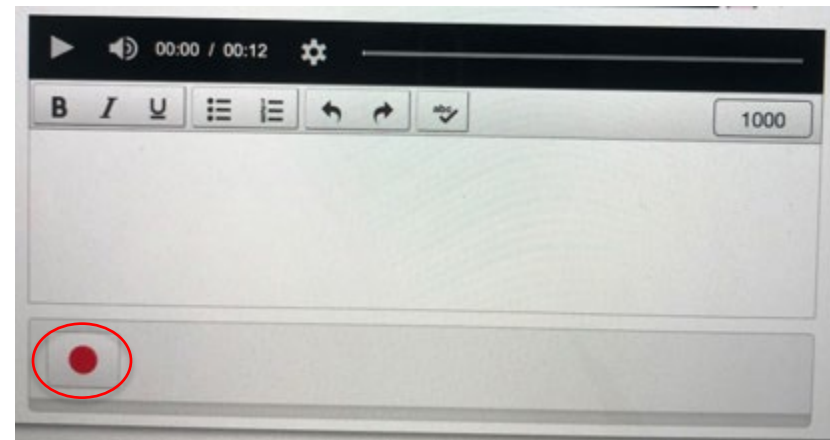


## TestNav System Requirements

TestNav supports audio recorder interactions only through the **TestNav app**, not the browser.

## Student Experience

Students will need a microphone in order to capture audio. On audio capture items, they click the **Record** button, which will then change to the speaking icon. The **Record** button doesn't have to be held down, just clicked. As they speak, they can see the progress the recording with the blue bar at the bottom. They should push **Stop** icon whenever they are done speaking and will see a confirmation that the recording is complete.

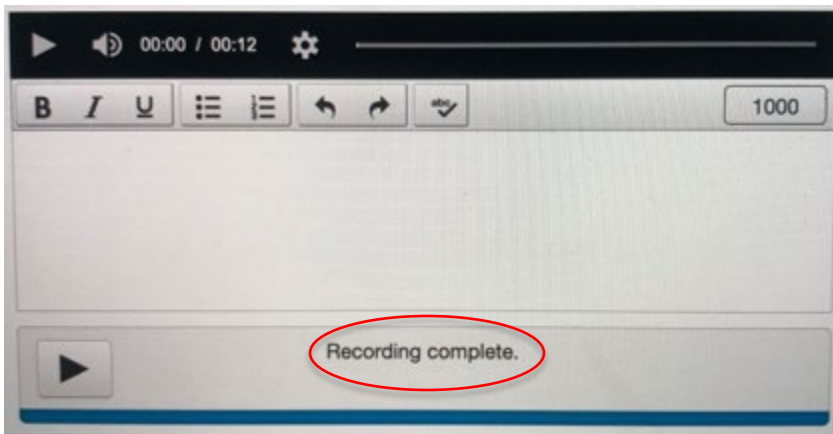


Underneath the prompt in the capture area, there is a red button to record audio when applicable.
